Hager Electro recalls 'mono' range of single module RCBO (combination RCD & MCB)

As a specialist provider of top quality electrical protection devices and solutions, Hager prides itself on the quality of our products and the safety of our customers.

A potential defect has been detected on Hager RCBO references AD310T, AD316T, AD320T & AD325T known as 'mono' resulting in a risk of electric shock.

Whilst the fault is very rare and estimated to affect only 0.15% of the products and in the absence of any serious incident, we have taken the voluntary decision to recall all of the products sold and installed in Australia and New Zealand.

Products affected include:

AD310T - 1 module RCBO 10A 30mA

AD316T - 1 module RCBO 16A 30mA

AD320T - 1 module RCBO 20A 30mA

AD325T - 1 module RCBO 25A 30mA

These products have been sold nationally from July 2010. No other Hager branded RCBO's are affected by this recall.



Recall progress

The Recall was initiated in December 2012. Hager has contacted all known purchasers; Wholesalers and Electrical Contractors. Whilst a large proportion of the affected products have been identified and replaced, Hager will continue to support the recall for all units identified and replaced.

Action required by contractors:

- 1. STOP installing the Recalled 'mono' product.
- 2. Return any stock of Recalled RCBOs to Hager for Replacement
- 3. Should you discover any installed Recalled RCBO;
 - Replace the Recalled RCBO with a suitable replacement
 - Retain the Recalled, Replaced RCBO
 - Register the installation details at www.hagerelectro.com.au/6862.htm
- 4. Hager will provide compensation for each returned, recalled RCBO, based on the Terms and Conditions available upon registration.
